Prevention

Hospice Care

- Palliation of Serious or Terminally Ill
 - Last Six months of life
 - Hospice becomes beneficiary
 - Revocations costs us all
 - Receiving Aggressive Therapy
 - High Risk Disease (COPD, AIDS)
 - History of 911 use
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Hospice Revocation Avoidance

- Enroll patients “at risk” for revocation
- Visit at home
 - Counsel – instruct – 10 digit access
 - “Register” patient in CAD
 - Co-respond with a “9-1-1” call
 - Help family through process
 - *While awaiting hospice RN*





Hospice Revocation Avoidance

- Program development
 - Enrollment Criteria
 - Protocol Approval
 - Care package
 - Response approval (MHP only)
 - Program QA
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Hospice Revocation Avoidance

- 99 patients referred
 - 43 patients successful in the end
 - 11 revocations
 - 10 calls to 9-1-1
 - 5 transports
 - 3 unrelated to hospice status
 - 2 direct admits to in-hospital hospice bed
 - No revocation
 - 32 still enrolled
