MORE URGENT EXPOSURES




OCCUPATIONAL MEDICINE IN DETROIT

- City wide contract (12,000 employees)– menu of services. Not FD specific.
- Multiple OSHA fines and concerns in past.
- 2013 – No N-95 program, in house TB testing (EMS division only), City Health Dept shut down by bankruptcy.
- 2015 Added 900 EMR in firefighting division
- Time to clean S&t up.

IDENTIFY, ANALYZE, DEVELOP, IMPLEMENT

- Started with Chaos
- Created “compliance center”
- Trained paramedics
- Capabilities of and expectation of occ med provider.
- Employees assigned by pension number digit to a month
- 30 days to complete, TB, fit test, review immunizations



