








2008 RNC (Final Numbers)

- 20,000 media (Media took over River Center and Roy Wilkins auditorium
- 5,000 delegates
- 15000 protestors
- 1000 anarchists
- USSS Protectees, 200 + Congressional Members, 20-30 Republican Governors, RNC VIP's/Delegates, Cabinet Members, Celebrities, etc. Boston

- Main DMAT: 6 MD's, 8 RN's, 6 paramedics, 1 pharmacist, 1 RT, 1 logistic and 1 communications specialist to support MMMU
- 24 DMAT personnel divided into 2 groups attached to Federal decontamination teams (CBIRF-170 U.S marines)
- 2 MD's, 2 RN's and 2 paramedics to LEC with tenting and supplies for medical treatment and decontamination prn

- 5 strike teams each composed of 2 MD's, 2 RN's and 2 paramedics equipped with vehicles, ALS packs, defibs with 12 lead, communications, foul weather gear etc
- 20 DMAT personnel split equally between SJH and UH
- 6 DMAT personnel at Regions Hospital (Lead hospital/Level I Trauma)

- 750 Impact ventilators
- 2 hour push pack response or on ground at MSP (747 full of medical equipment)
- 500 Cyanokits, 250-500 Ca EDTA and 500 Prussian blue tx's
- 1 Federal Medical Station on call

- 13 MFF's-80+ police with 2 tactical medics per
- 6 cut teams, both police and fire
- 420 police inside XA
- 1000 USSS agents in and out of XA
- 400 busses each with an officer
- 500 officers outside of building
- 4 JHAT's (Joint Hazard Assessment Teams)- FBI, USSS, SPPD, SPFD, Haz Mat
- 4 JHERT's (Joint Hazard Explosive Response Teams)- FBI, USSS, SPPD, DOE, bomb squad

- MACC (Multi Agency Communications/Coordination Center)- 140 seats with hosp reps
- Interior Command Center
- Exterior Command Center
- JOC (Joint Operations Center)
- JIC (Joint Information Center)
- EOC (Emergency Operations Center- multiple)
- USAR (Urban Search and Rescue team)
- F16 and attack helicopters in air at all times

Medical Plan

Normal Medical Operations (City of St. Paul per plan)

- EMS will evaluate all pts outside of building and do preliminary triage to DMAT or to hospital
- DMAT will tx and release or re-triage to hospital
- All east metro EMS traffic directed by MRCC
 - MRCC is the control valve esp for Regions
- No control of walk-in traffic

The Venue (XA)

Medical Station Operations (per plan)

- Walk-in patients
- Sicker pts transported to HCS to tx and release or transfer
- Transfer to hosp by amb outside of door by interior medic/medic team roving team
- Critical patient accompanied by Medical Station staff
- Ambulance secured at Hospital

Outside the Building

- 2 SPF ambulances (1 and 1 with SSM) in venue area
- 2 SPF ambulances in non-vehicle area
- 2 gators
- SPF and scheduled mutual aid mix for city
- MASS decontamination capability (40,000)
 with CBIRF

Health Station Staffing (Peak)

- 2 Staff MD's
- 2 ML provider (resident or PA)
- 4 RN's
- 1 Security guard
- MD's, ML's and RN's worked overlapping hour shifts (12N to 10PM and 4PM to 12MN)

- Event suspicious for terrorist action usually an explosion
- "Bag and Drag" with further care enroute when possible
- Reporting possible secondary devices (all SPFD units cross trained with bomb squad)

RESULTS

Results (Law Enforcement)

- 800+ arrests total with 283 on Day 1 with 119 felonies
- Multiple uses of gas, mace and flash bangs

Results (Medical)

Results (XA)

- 195 pt contacts with 46 w/u's
- One lac repair and one paronychia done by the Chair of the Dept of Surgery
- Most cases minor: blisters (seemed like hundreds), back pain, URI's, minor HA's
- 7 transports from XA and 2 from RVA
- Transported pt's included: syncope, allergy, SOB, CP, psych, HA

 - Sept. 1 149/44
 - Sept. 2 79/8
 - Sept. 3 83/6

 - Totals 410/70
