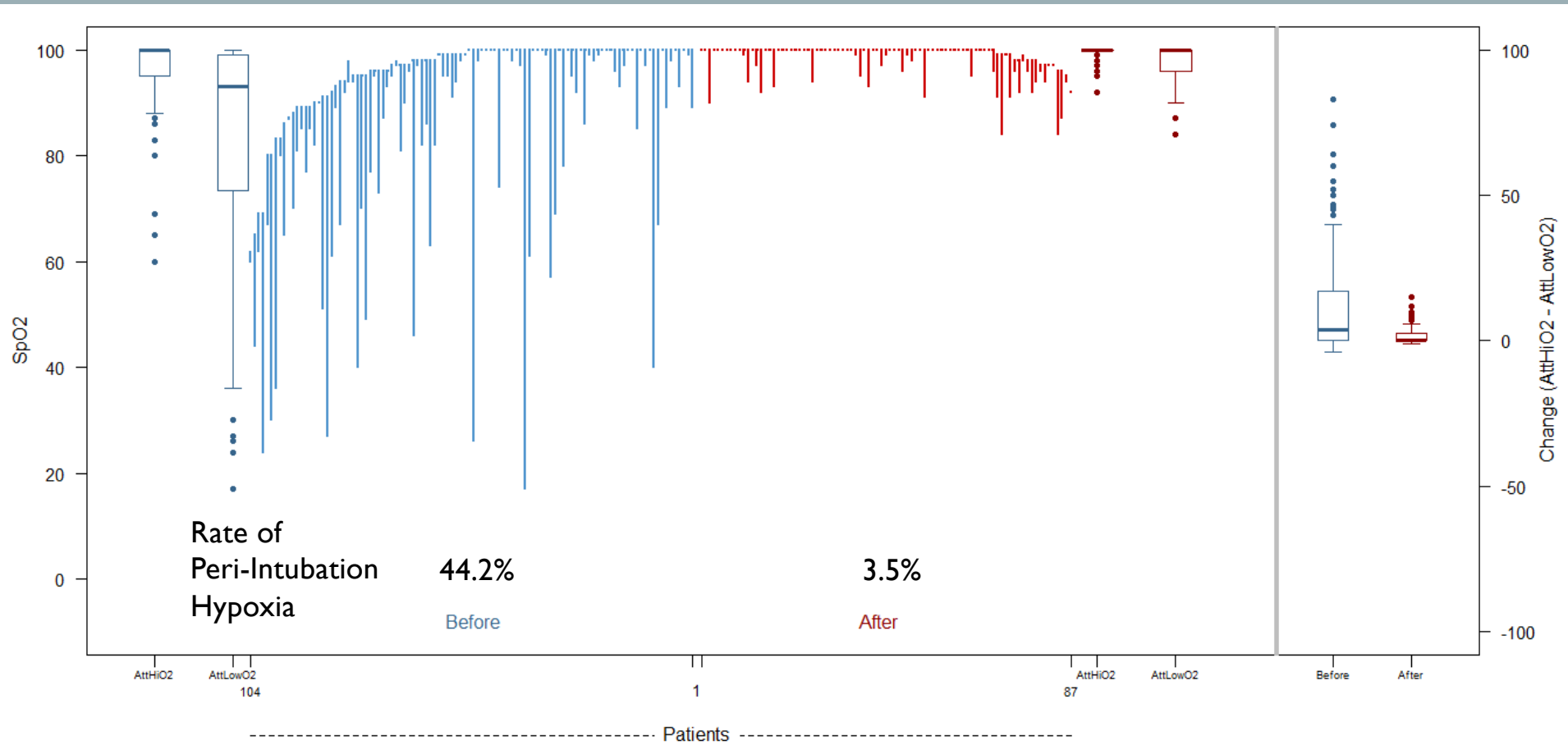
Predictable

STOP Intubating Hypoxic Patients!

The PreOx Toolbox

1. Positioning (E2SN/Pint Sipping/HoB elevated)
2. PEEP, Two-handed seal, “Lift/Don’t Push”
3. Waveform capnography for every breath
4. Apneic Oxygenation
5. Flush rate oxygen
6. DSI
7. Goal-directed saturations
